

## New!! On-Call Bulky Item Pick-up Service

Recology Yuba-Sutter is providing a new service in addition to your annual Free Dump Coupon. The service is designed to help customers who can't get to the dump but need to dispose of a large item such as a mattress or appliance, excess plant materials, or another bulky or awkward item. ***This service is available once a year at no additional cost to all residential customers who use our three cart recycling system.*** Customers who do not have the three cart system can use their Pick-up Service coupon for a second Free Dump at either the Marysville or Ponderosa Transfer Stations. The \$10 Freon Certification Fee still applies for free collection or free dump of refrigerators and air conditioners.

### How Much Can RYS Pick-up for Free?

#### **You have a choice!**

Up to two (2) cubic yards of bagged debris per household – that's ten (10) 32 gallon bags and

One large item that weighs 200 pounds or less – a sofa, a mattress, a dishwasher or other appliance (\$10 Freon Certification Fee applies to refrigerators and air conditioners)

#### **OR**

One television or personal computer with monitor

Additional Bulky Item Collections can be scheduled for a fee. Call 743-6933 for more info.

### Got Toxics?

No hazardous waste (paint, oil, batteries, fluorescent tubes, or household chemicals) can be collected through this new service. Recology Yuba-Sutter and the Regional Waste Management Authority are

### So, How Do I Use My On-Call Bulky Item Pick-up Coupon?

**You must make a reservation in advance to use this new service.** Call 743-6933 to request a bulky item pick-up. Pick-ups will be scheduled for your regular service day. You do not need to be home for the pick-up. Just place your items at the curb attach your coupon let us do the rest! **Keep appliances and TVs or computers separate from your bagged debris.**

### I'd Rather Just Dump Myself, Thanks

All customers receive one Free Dump Coupon per year for free disposal of up to five (5) cubic yards. Any customer can use their Bulky Item Coupon as a second Free Dump Coupon at either the Marysville or Ponderosa Transfer Stations.

### ON-CALL BULKY ITEM PICK-UP COUPON

Acceptable items and restrictions for the **On-call Bulky Item Pick-Up Service** are:

- Maximum of two (2) cubic yards of bagged debris per household (equal to (10) 32-gallon cans or bags).

#### **And**

- One (1) large item (such as a couch) or appliance (such as a dishwasher or refrigerator) that does **not** exceed 200 pounds. Refrigerators require special handling and must be requested at the same time that you schedule your pick-up date. There will be a \$10 Freon Certification Fee for Freon Appliances.

#### **Or**

- One (1) Computer monitor, TV or personal computer.

### ONE FREE DUMP COUPON

Free Dump Coupon is Redeemable at either the Ponderosa Transfer Station or Recology Yuba-Sutter Transfer Station located at 3001 N. Levee Road in Marysville.

Open 7 days per week. 7:30 AM to 4:30 PM.

- Present coupon at scale house when entering.
- Must weigh in and out.
- No commercial vehicles (over 1 ton) or hazardous waste will be accepted.
- Limit to one (1) vehicle or one (1) trailer
- Maximum of five (5) cubic yards (One pick-up Or small trailer)
- Tires will be limited to four (4) and must be 11r24.5 Size or smaller.
- There will be a \$10 Freon Certification Fee for appliances containing Freon.

## WHERE DO ALL THE WORN OUT TIRES GO?

Have you ever had to lug 4 tires, say from your garage to the car? The average tire weighs 22 pounds, which means almost 100 pounds for four tires. Now consider that Americans buy 200 million new car tires each year, plus 16 million truck tires. It turns out that Yuba City entrepreneur Terry Brown has found a product that is "green" in an unusual way and helps complete the recycling process for tires. Terry's business, EverGreen TuffTurf, is supplied by a manufacturer that has already recycled 1 billion pounds of rubber.

Terry is a distributor for two landscape products that use recycled materials in their manufacturing process. The first is Rubber Bark™ an environmentally friendly landscaping material that is made entirely from recycled tires. It looks just like wood chips or rock, but lasts 12 times longer than wood mulch, absorbs no water, and reduces weed growth. It also stays where it's put! The second is ForeverLawn™ who manufactures a variety of synthetic grasses for lawns, playgrounds, and sports fields. The synthetic grasses are manufactured from a variety of recycled rubber and have the added bonus of never needing water or mowing.

When it comes to Terry's business two things are quite clear: that's a lot of tires, and it's a big step in the right direction – the green direction. View outdoor product display at 735 Clark Ave., Yuba City.
